**WHEREAS, Women's March SLO stands in solidarity to protect women's rights, human rights, our safety, health, and planet, as we move toward a positive and just future; and**

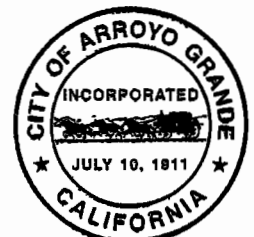
