NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Arroyo Grande Planning Commission will conduct a public hearing on **TUESDAY, OCTOBER 4, 2022 at 6:00 p.m.**, or soon thereafter, to consider the following item:

CONSIDERATION OF APPEAL 22-001; APPEAL OF PLOT PLAN REVIEW 22-026 FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A VACATION RENTAL; LOCATION – 1136 EAST GRAND AVENUE

After reviewing the administratively approved applications on the August 2, 2022 agenda, the Planning Commission requested additional review of the above referenced application. The Planning Commission will reconsider the Community Development Director's approval of Plot Plan Review 22-026 to establish a Vacation Rental in the Fair Oaks Mixed Use zoning district.

In compliance with the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), the Community Development Department has determined the project is categorically exempt per Section 15301 of the CEQA Guidelines regarding existing facilities.

This Planning Commission meeting is being conducted in a hybrid in-person/virtual format. Members of the public that prefer to participate virtually may do so by joining the Zoom meeting option. If you challenge the proposed action in court, you may be limited to raising only those issues you or someone else raised at the public hearing described in this notice, or in written correspondence delivered to the Planning Commission at, or prior to, the public hearing. Failure of any person to receive the notice shall not constitute grounds for any court to invalidate the action of the legislative body for which the notice was given.
